Suggestions/Discussions

Dr. Whyni Gopi IQAC Coordinator welcomed the gathering. Vice Principal Rev.Dr. Thomas Joseph Parathara felicitated and thanked the Principal Dr.Anitha Jose for the contribution towards IQAC and NAAC. Dr. Anitha Jose also addressed the gathering and

felicitated all the previous IQAC members for their great contribution and hardwork towards NAAC accreditation. The IQAC members then started discussing on the agenda matters.

1. Dr. Rani Maria Thomas suggested for visiting various colleges, where NEP is implemented, to study their activities and work. Dr Kamakshy shared the possibilities of industry linkage as discussed in their BoS. As syllabus revision was going on, external members suggested legal incorporation of modules in the curriculum, as per the role of the industry. They also suggested, starting new certificate courses with industry linkage, to makes students more industry ready.

Dr Joseph Job gave a few suggestions regarding making/ improving placements. He suggested in training students with soft skills with the linkage with an organisation. It would be possible to give such training with the help of CSR funds.

2. Discussions regarding conducting common courses in English on cross- cutting issues for the UG students were carried out. It was finally decided to offer the causes in V semester on Environment and Human rights as it was done earlier. But it was suggested to add a module on cyber security on the in the present syllabus revision being carried out. Dr Joseph Job also suggested starting courses on disaster management including sessions on First Aid, CPR etc.
3. Dr. Rekha Mathews & and Dr.Joseph Job gave good suggestions regarding strengthening alumnae.
 - i. Keep a senior faculty as charge of the Alumnae Association.
 - ii. Give a clear project and estimate of funding for Alumnae for raising funds from them.
 - iii. Conduct yearly alumnae meetings
4. It was also decided to conduct regular sessions for knowledge updating for the non-teaching staff and also collect opinions from them.
5. A discussion on the implementation of UBA by the college was carried out.
