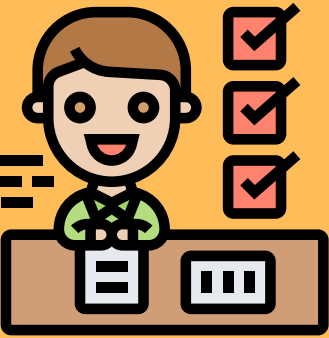


# STUDENT SATISFACTION SURVEY 2022 - 2023



The student satisfaction survey conducted at Assumption College, Autonomous, during the 2022-23 academic year reveals a generally positive sentiment among the 535 randomly selected undergraduate (UG) and postgraduate (PG) students.

The results of the student satisfaction survey at Assumption College, Autonomous, for the academic year 2022-23, paint a highly positive picture of the teaching and learning environment. The overwhelming majority of students express satisfaction across various aspects, indicating a well-rounded educational experience.

## HIGHLIGHTS

● Key strengths include the comprehensive coverage of the syllabus (83%) and the high level of teacher preparation (98%), contributing to effective communication within groups (93%).

● Notably, the fairness of the internal evaluation process is appreciated by 95% of students, and 82% feel their teachers provide personalized attention to assignments.



● The institution's commitment to holistic development is evident, with 78% of students acknowledging the positive impact of teaching and mentoring on cognitive, social, and emotional growth.

● While 60% of students recognize the provision of multiple opportunities for learning and growth, there is room for improvement in addressing weaknesses, as 76% feel their teachers could do more to help overcome difficulties.



● Positive perceptions extend to student-centric methods (95%) and the integration of ICT tools (87%), showcasing a commitment to innovative and varied teaching approaches.

● Moreover, the emphasis on soft skills, life skills, and employability skills (95%) highlights a forward-looking approach to preparing students for the professional world.



## SUGGESTIONS

- **Diversify Teaching Methods** - Encourage teachers to explore diverse teaching methods beyond traditional approaches.
- **Feedback Mechanism for Weaknesses** - Implement a structured feedback mechanism where students can provide anonymous feedback about areas where they feel the institution and teachers could improve.
- **Enhance Personalized Attention** - While a significant percentage of students appreciate personal discussions about assignments, consider ways to increase individualized attention for students who feel they need more support.
- **Increase Opportunities for Learning and Growth** - Explore ways to expand extracurricular activities, internships, and field visit programs. This can provide a more holistic learning experience.
