2021-2022

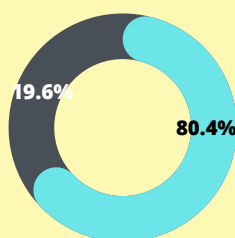
The Student Satisfaction Survey (SSS) was conducted among the students of the college through a google form. The questionnaire was framed based on the guidelines of NAAC. The survey was aimed to capture the responses of the students towards the teaching learning process. The students have rated the question on a scale of 0-4, 4-strongly agree, 3-agree, 2-neutral, 1-disagree, 0-strongly disagree. The result of this survey is based on the responses of **612** students.

Population Demography

Total-612

Bachelors-80.4%

Masters-19.6%



Coverage of syllabus

85.5% of students agreed that more than **70%** of syllabus was covered.



Teacher's Preparedness

95% of the students appreciated the preparedness of the teachers with the remark '**Thoroughly**'

87.3% agreed that the level of communication of the teachers were '**Very Effective**'.

Use of ICT

Efforts are taken by the institution/teachers to inculcate soft skills, life skills and employability skills to make the students ready for the world of work and it was appreciated to a great extent by **89.4%** of students.



Provision for Internships/Field trips

The college has put continuous efforts and **84.2%** of students mentioned that internships/field trips are arranged on regular basis

Fairness of internal evaluation

The evaluation process and transparency in the system is well applauded by **92%** of the students.



Teaching & Mentoring

89.7% agrees that teaching and mentoring process in the college facilitates them in cognitive, social and emotional growth.

91.4% agrees that student centric methods like experiential, participatory, problem solving learning techniques are part of teaching and learning process.



Overall Teaching and Learning Process

With the implementation of modern and distinctive pedagogical methods, the college could gain the satisfaction level up to Excellent/ Good from **79.2%** of students.
