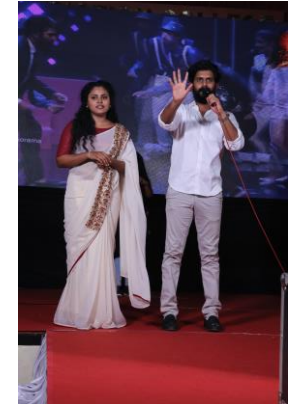


# COLLEGE UNION DHRUVA 2018 – 19
