World Environment Day celebrations - June 5, 2021







Anemia Awareness Campaign - June 16, 2021






<u>Participation in World Blood Donors Day celebration by Kottayam District Administration – June 17, 2021</u>

The second activity was to take online pledge for making Yoga – internal part of the life at https://pledge.mygov.in/integrate-yoga-lifestyle/


This was done as per the direction of UGC and Govt. of India. The volunteers who took online pledge were awarded certificates with their name.




International Plastic Bag Free Day- July 3, 2021


Webinar on Women's Rights - July 24, 2021










Hiroshima Day- August 7, 2021










International Organic Day - Sep 22, 2021









NSS Day - Sep 24, 2021

Gandhi Jayanthi - Oct 2, 2021










National Unity Day - Oct 29, 2021






Online Orientation session for first year NS Volunteers - Nov 4, 2021






Online Awareness session on Muscular Dystrophy - Nov 4, 2021






National Cancer Awareness Day - Nov 6, 2021

<u>Anti-littering Campaign - November - December 2021</u>



Constitution Day Online Preamble Reading - Nov 26, 2021



Voter Registration Help Desk - Nov 29, 2021












World Human Rights Day Celebration - Dec 10, 2021


<u>Candle Light Tribute to CDS General Bipin Rawat and his wife and 12 soldiers - Dec</u> 13, 2021


Microgreen cultivation - Dec 20, 2021 - Jan 10, 2022


Anti-Dowry Campaign - December 23, 2021



National Youth Day - January 12, 2022









Parakram Diwas - January 23, 2022






National Girl Child Day - January 23, 2022






REPUBLIC DAY - Jan 26, 2022









MARTYRS' DAY - Jan 30, 2022








International Day For Women & Girls In Science - Feb 11, 2022










World Water Day - March 22, 2022








Shaheed Diwas - March 23, 2022








World Health Day Celebrations - April 8, 2022


The first year NSS volunteers of Mathematics dept. created an awareness video on the theme of World health Day "Our Planet, Our health" and it is shared among the students.



Low Carbon Diet Awareness - April 2022











FoodPrint Calculation - April 23, 2022



World Malaria Day Celebration - April 25, 2022











Rabindranath Tagore Jayanti- May 7, 2022








International Nurses Day-May 12, 2022
