

ONE WEEK WORKSHOP FOR YOGA PRACTICE






YOGA DAY CELEBRATION - JUNE 21










AZADI KA AMRIT MAHOTSAV






INTERNATIONAL PEACE DAY,2022

WORLD OZONE DAY










WORLD RIVER DAY, September 25









AROGYAMRUTHAM 2022, SEPTEMBER 28






WORLD HEART DAY, SEPTEMBER 29


International day of older persons - October 1,2022


WORLD MENTAL HEALTH DAY, OCTOBER 10 2022






ANTI-DRUG AWARENESS QUIZ COMPETITION AND PLEDGE



WORLD STUDENTS DAY, October 15,2022



CATCH THE RAIN CAMPAIGNONLINE PLEDGE










FLASH MOB AGAINST DRUG ABUSE


KERALA PIRAVI, NOVEMBER 1






Chaya Mansa Plant distribution






Antidrug Awareness Debate Competition - First prize




Road Safety Awareness

E-Waste Pledge to Save the Earth




ORGANIC FARMING


KINDNESS DAY








Nature walk




World Cancer Day

Women's Day 2023




Yuvatha 2023
